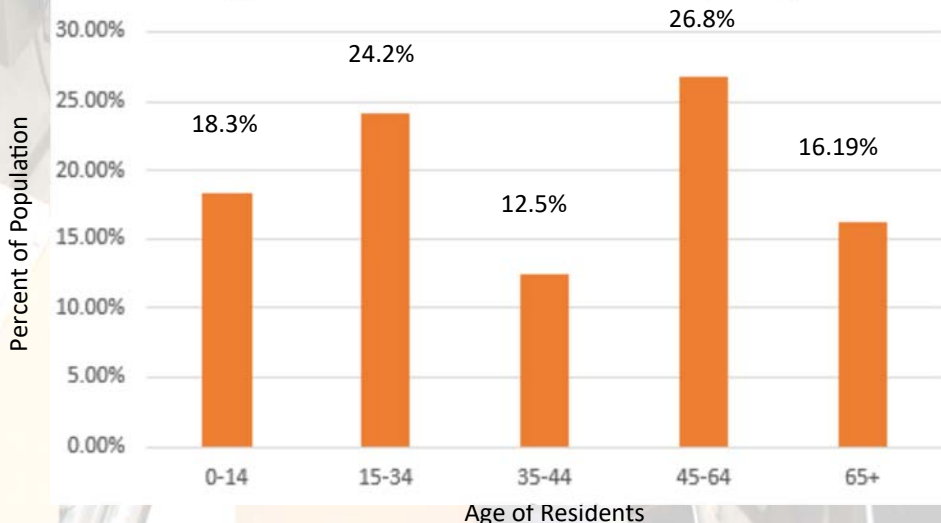
Parish Race and Ethnicity (2016)
